RE: TO SUPPORT LYNXX NETWORKS' BEAD FUNDING APPLICATIONS FOR BROADBAND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT IN LA CROSSE COUNTY

WHEREAS, in 2023, La Crosse County became certified through the Wisconsin Public Service Commission as a Broadband Forward! and Telecommuter Forward! Community; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, the State of Wisconsin was allocated \$1,055,823,573.71 from the National Telecommunications and Information Administration through the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act for the Broadband, Access, Equity, and Deployment (BEAD) Program; and

WHEREAS, The Wisconsin Public Service Commission opened round 1 of BEAD funding for approved applicants on January 13th; and

WHEREAS, BEAD applicants receive seven (7) points towards their BEAD application for county endorsement, which must be provided by February 25^{th} , 2025, and

WHEREAS, La Crosse County is committed to working with Lynxx Networks to support BEAD projects throughout La Crosse County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the La Crosse County Board of Supervisors endorses Lynxx Networks' application for BEAD funding for project units in the Towns of Barre, Burns, Farmington, Greenfield, Hamilton, and Onalaska in La Crosse County.
