APPROVAL OF MINUTES

REVIEW OF 2Q RATE A MEAL CARD RESULTS

Carissa Pagel-Smith, ADRC Manager/Director, reviewed the results of *Rate a Meal Cards* received during second quarter 2019. Cards were distributed randomly throughout second quarter to capture feedback of participants at Aramark (Forest Park, Harry J Olson Senior Center, Stokke) and School District of Holmen (Holmen Community Center, Onalaska Community Center) catered meal sites.

REVIEW OF SENIOR LIFE SURVEY RESULTS

Carissa Pagel-Smith, ADRC Manager/Director, reviewed the results of a recent survey to capture feedback on the Senior Life newsletter. Overwhelming, respondents expressed satisfaction in current layout/format as well as content. Additionally, among the comments received via the survey, no major trends were identified. Therefore, at this time, no significant changes will be made to the newsletter.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT/UPDATES

Carissa Pagel-Smith, ADRC Manager/Director, provided current updates. Updates included:

- Several Dementia Care Specialist program updates, many of which are now included on our website at www.lacrossecounty.org/adrc/dementia as well as on Calendar of Events.
- The first Aging Mastery Program (AMP) class will begin September 16, 2019. This five-week, evidence-based program is available via a partnership with Inclusa and the Greater Wisconsin Agency on Aging Resources (GWAAR). Location and time of class to be determined.
- 85 households have participated in our drug pick-up program; nearly 40 pounds collected. Piloted onsite collection in June at Holmen and Harry J Olson meal sites. Goal is to pilot residential community pick-up (i.e., Heritage Village) by December 31, 2019. Other events:
