### **AGENCY UPDATES**

- **Courts** –Todd Bjerke shared with the group that they are waiting to get trauma informed training going. Judge Gonzalez is presenting at the Child Welfare and Courts Conference on September 30<sup>th</sup> - October 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- **Police** - Shawn Kudron shared that the Police Department is recognizing kids that are doing well. Taking kids out for ice cream and visiting with them at the boys and girls club. When it comes to picking the children they are visiting, they use their instincts in regards to what kids they think need help.
- **Schools** – Kate Mayer shared that Hogan School Board wrote about how much money the school board is going to get which is close to a million (maybe more) that school districts have been at a loss. No raises for teachers and no increase for students. Most districts will have to cut programs and staff. Rebuilding for Education conference is coming up and will be focusing on trauma which is so important for the school district.
- **Human Services** – Jason Witt shared with the group that for today we will be focusing on La Crosse Area Family Collaborative. We had a two day Judge Teske meeting back in May and we will be having cultural competency trainings offered with \$15,000 of funds through a grant. That group is also working with the police department that received a grant to train the trainers and they will be coming to La Crosse for 20-25 participants. They would like to do cross system trainings in schools, human services, and juvenile justice systems.

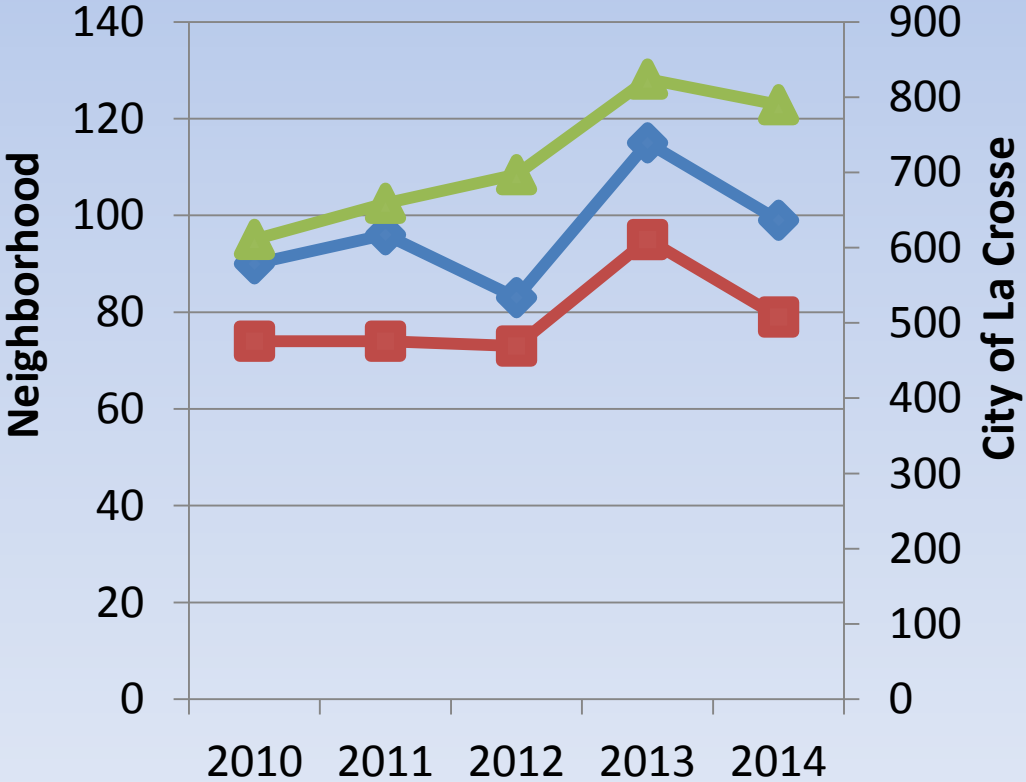

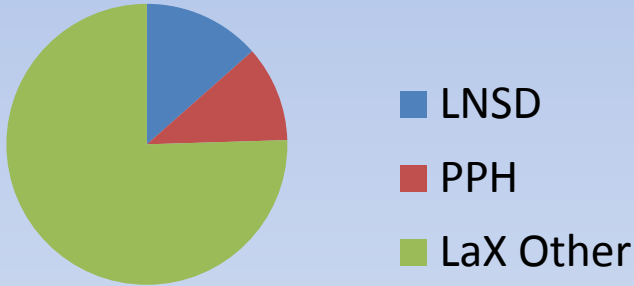
# Data Analysis: Child Protective Services (CPS) Referrals

Number of CPS Referrals

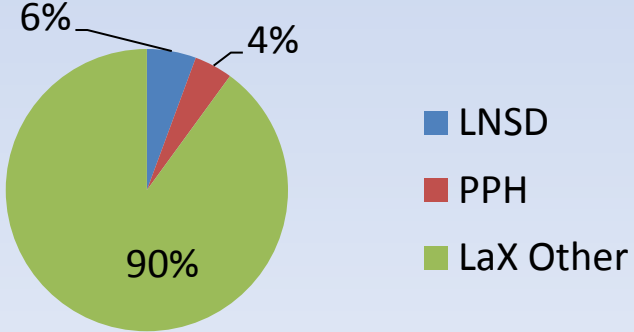
◆ LNSD    ■ PPH    ▲ City of LaX

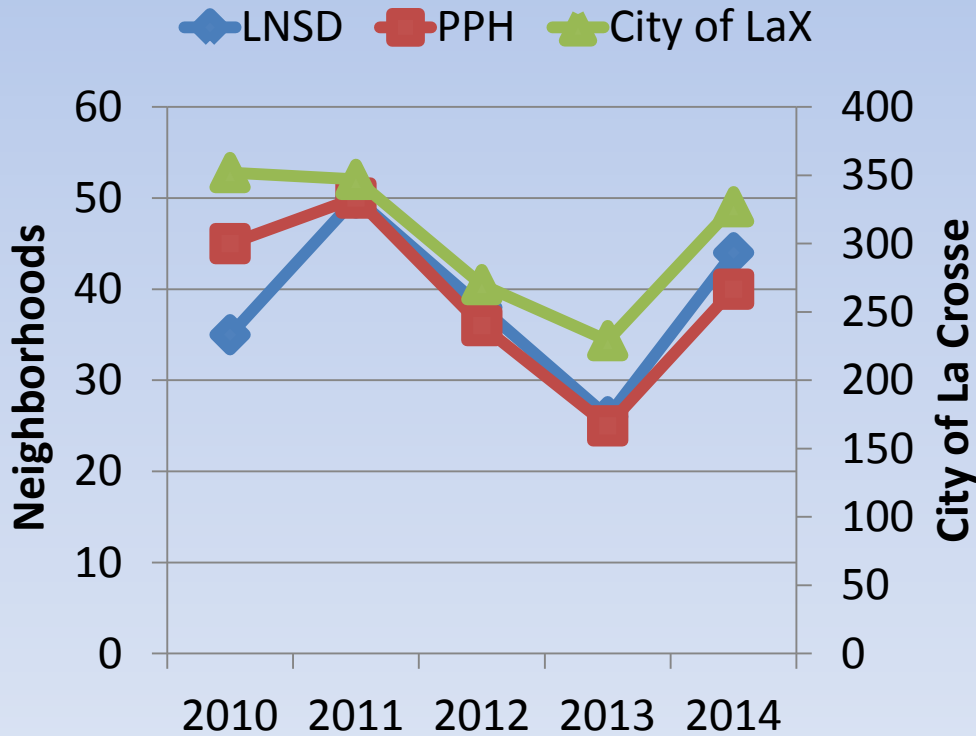




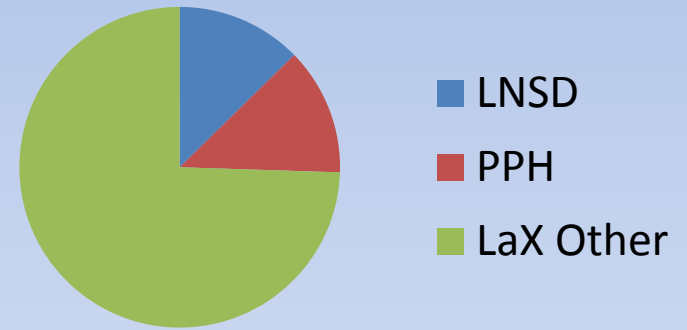

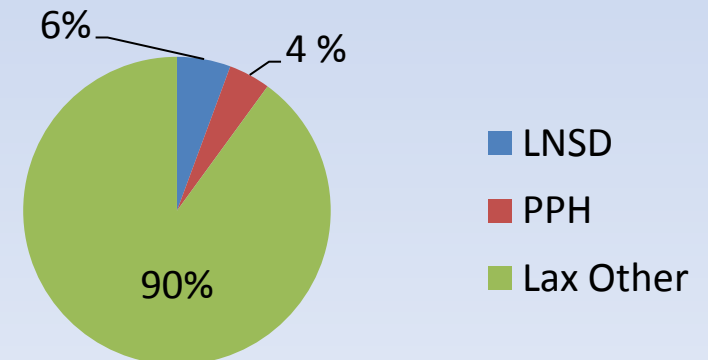
## Number JJ Referrals: 2010-2014



## Percent of JJ Referrals: 2010-2014



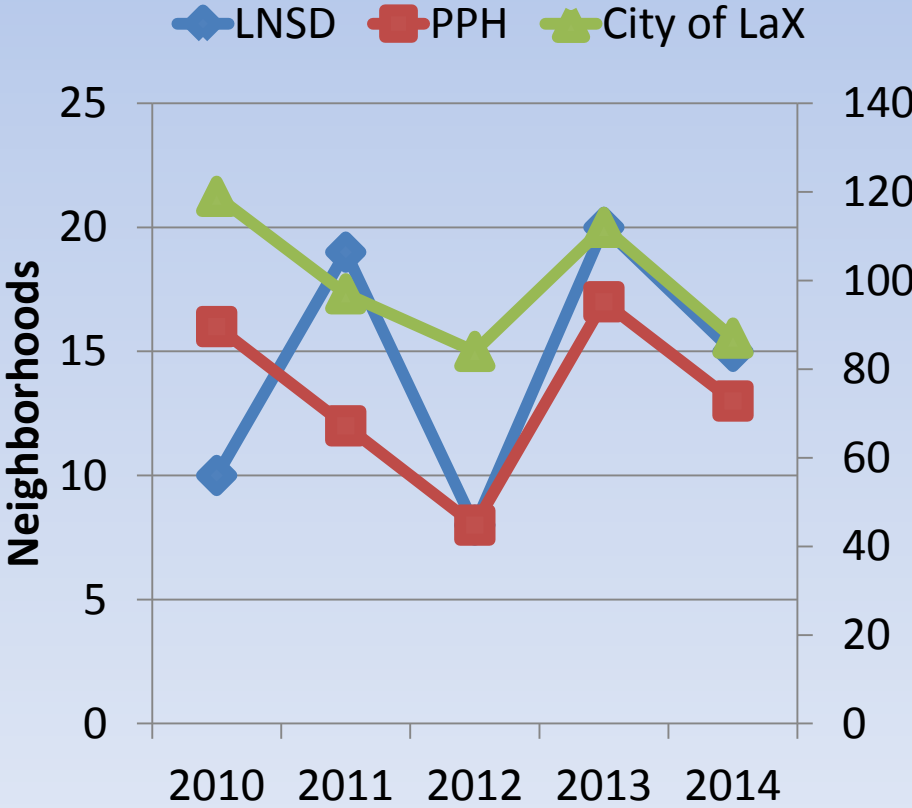

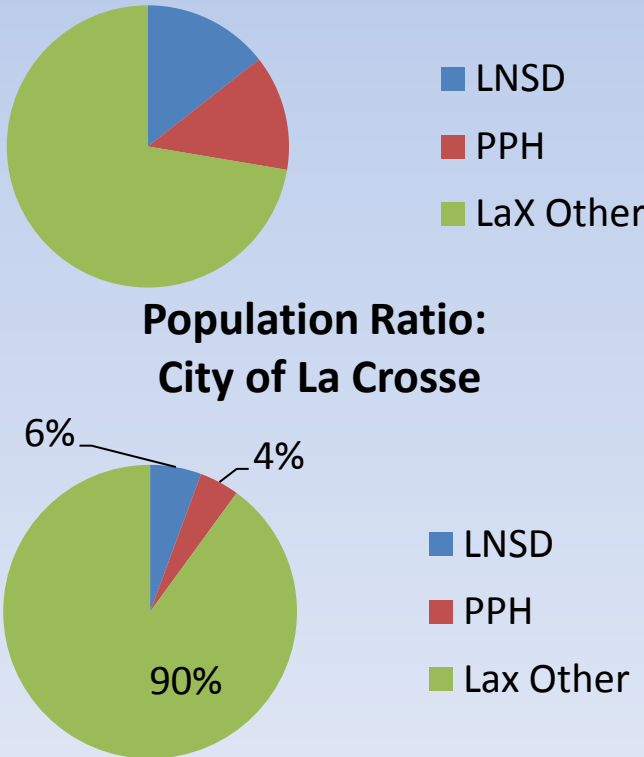


# Data Analysis: JJ Cases Open for Sup.

Percent of JJ Cases Open for Sup.: 2010-2014

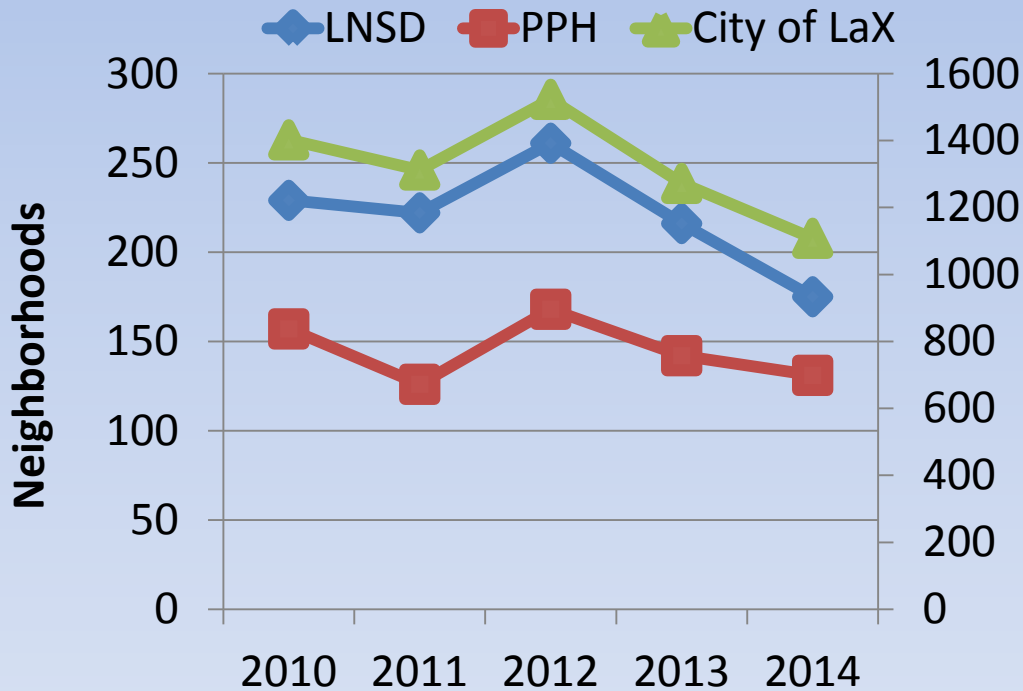




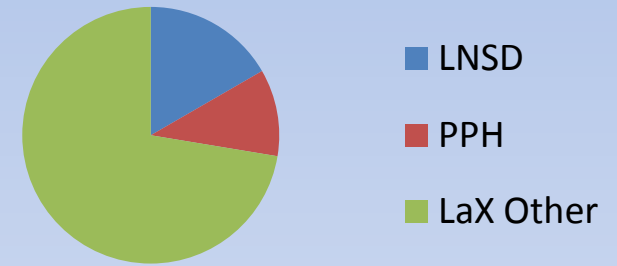

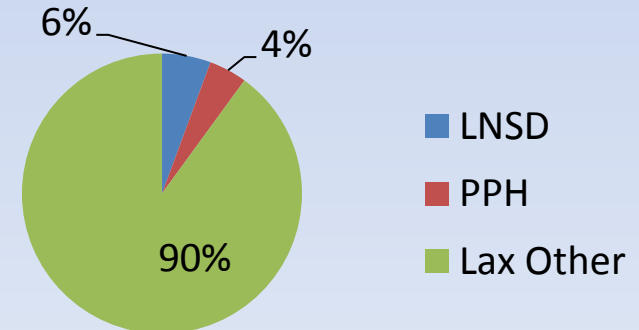
**Number of Crimes: 2010-2014**

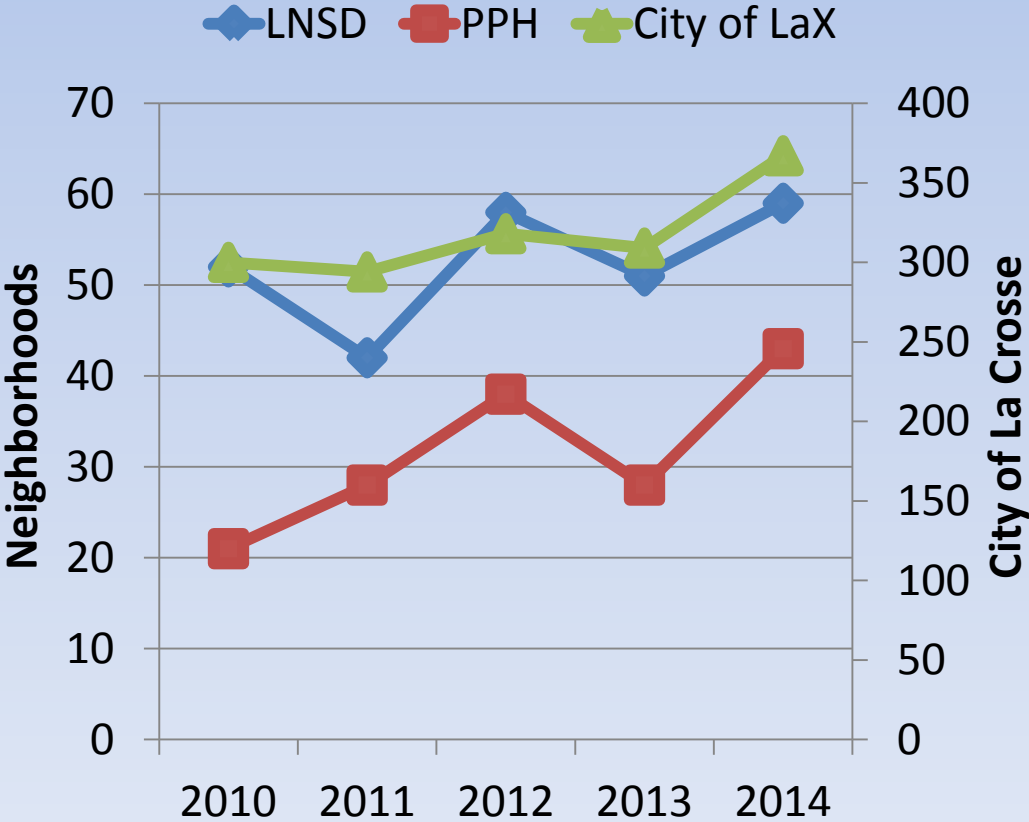

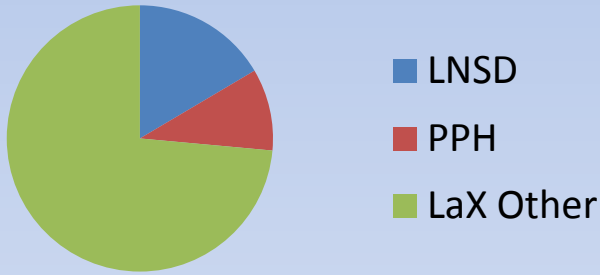


# Data Analysis: Uniform Controlled Substance Crimes

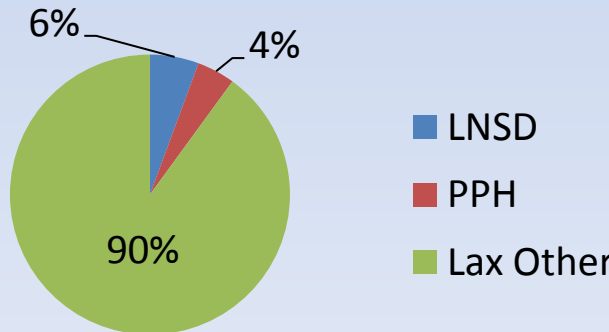
**Number of Uniform Controlled Substance Crimes: 2010-2014**

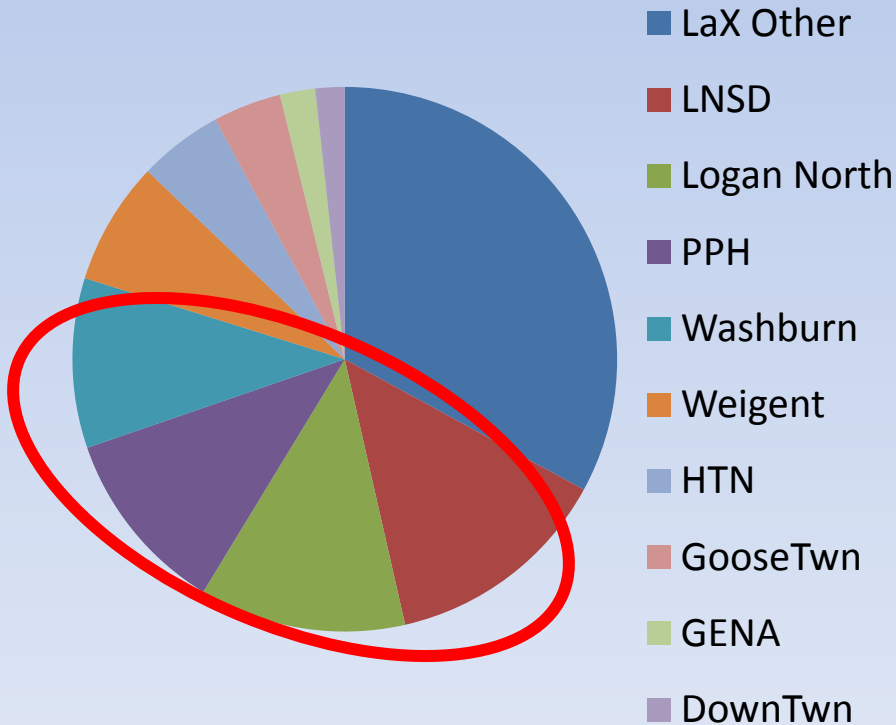




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# Overall Picture & Conclusions

## Conclusions:

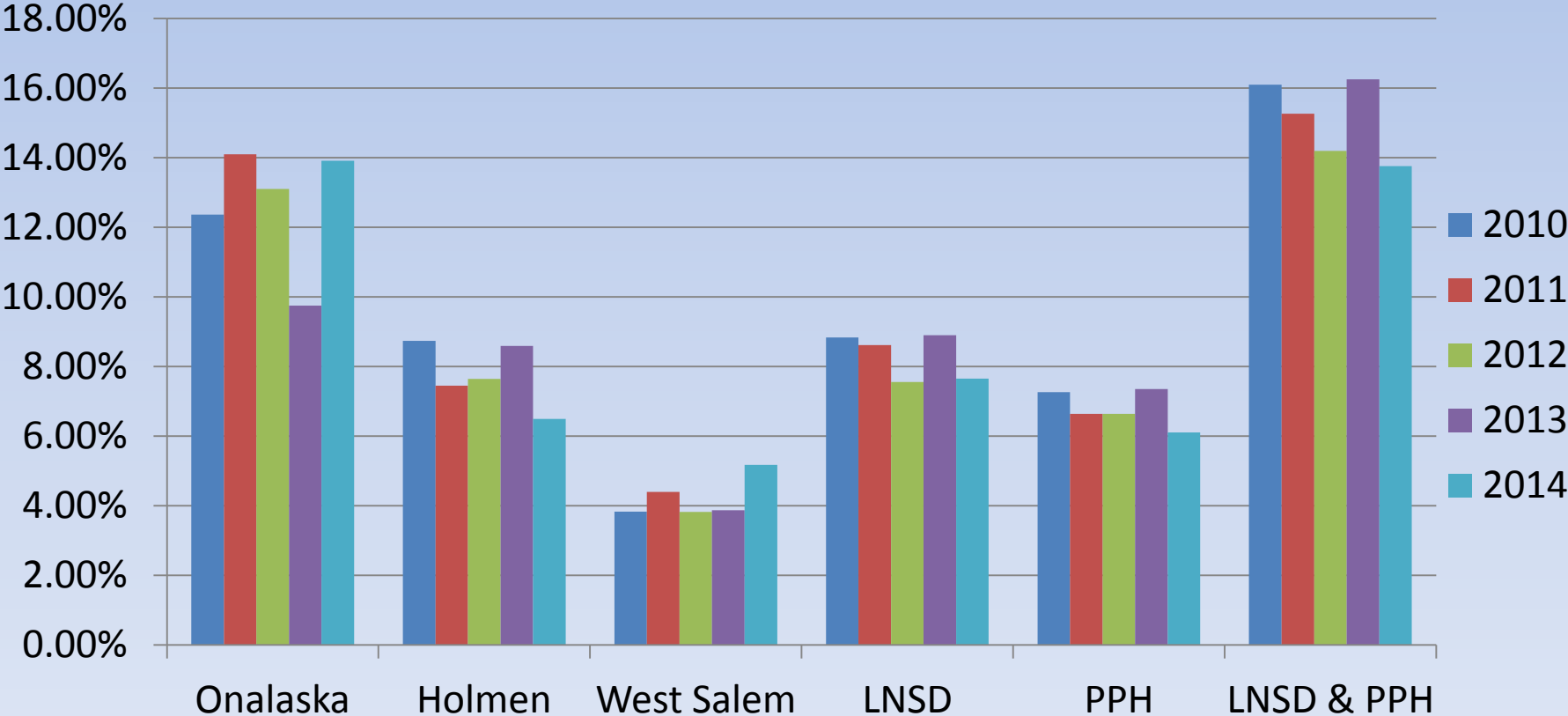
- When analyzing LNSD & PPH, ~1 in 4 referrals, cases, crimes, etc.
- Expand lens, look at all neighborhoods across all indicators, ~50% of all referrals, cases, crimes, etc. analyzed were from:
  - Lower Northside Depot
  - Powell-Poage-Hamilton
  - Washburn
  - Logan North
- Total Approximate Population of LNSD, PPH, Washburn, and Logan North: 11,390
  - ~22% of the population lives in these 4 neighborhoods but 50% of referrals, cases, and crimes were from these areas
- The LAFC should touch all 4 neighborhoods

**Percent of CPS Referrals: 2010-2014**

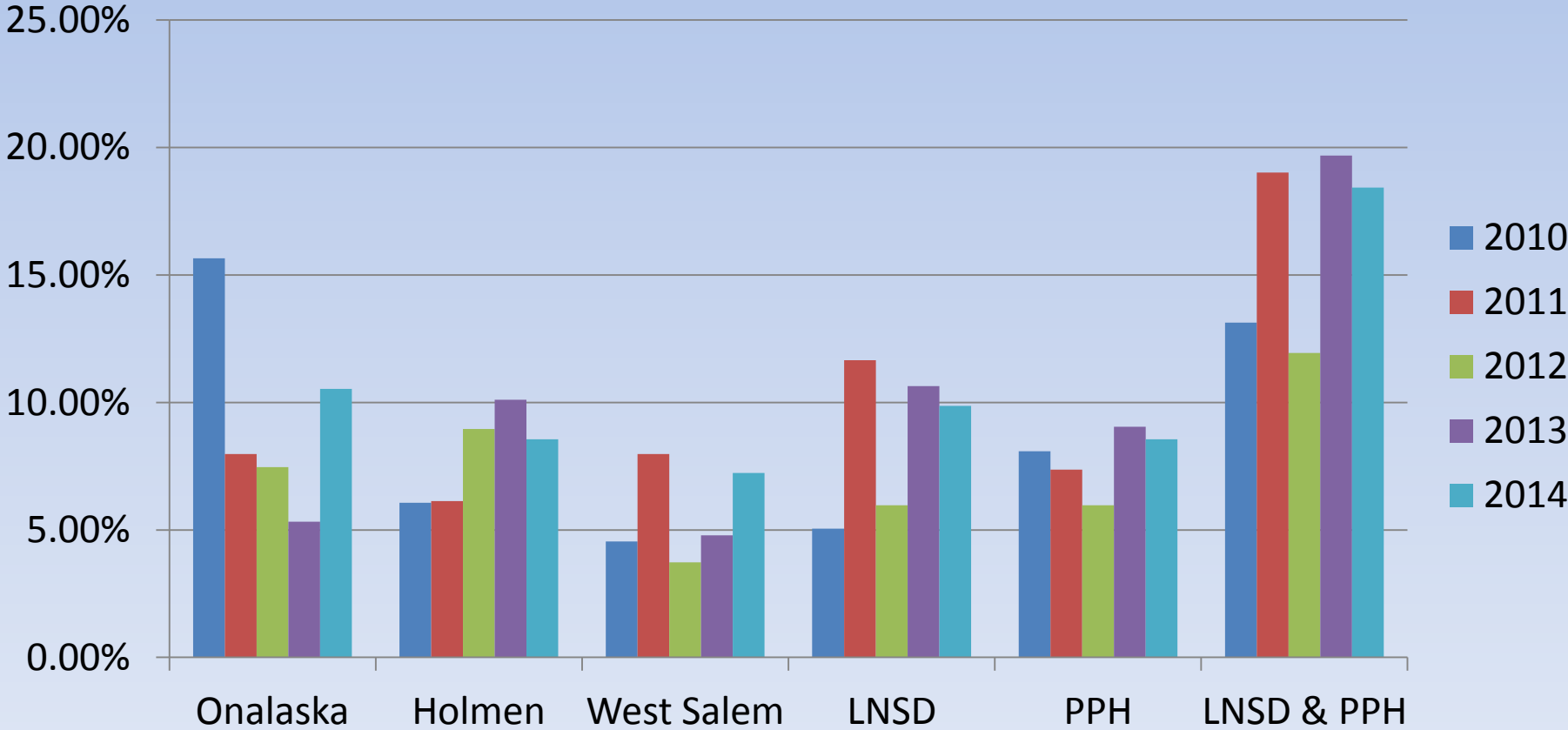
