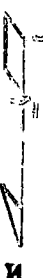

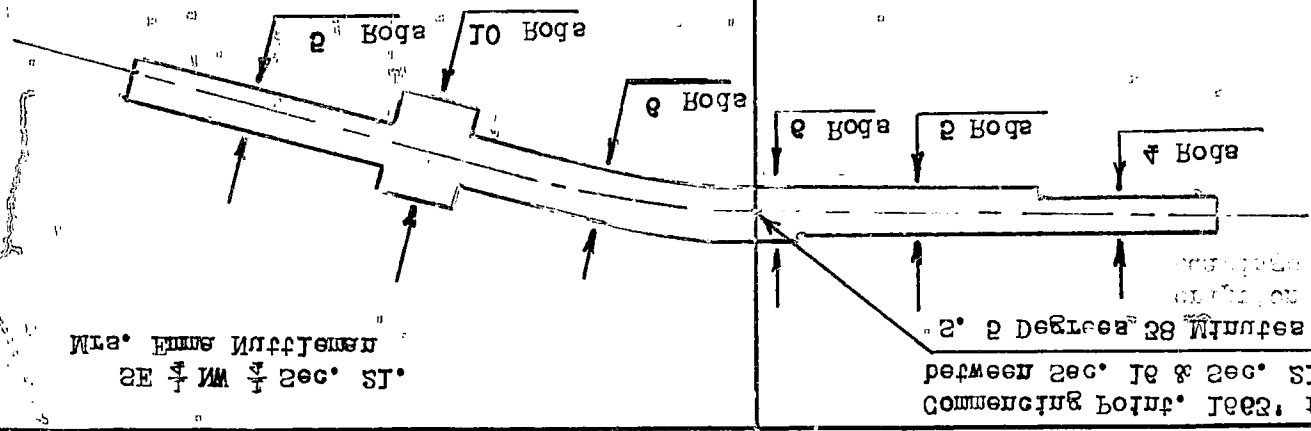


Center of Section 31.

It having been deemed necessary for the proper improvement of a County Highway to change or relocate a portion thereof, through lands owned by Fred Miller and Lena Miller, his wife, in the Town of Barre, La Crosse County, and a plat showing the existing location and the proposed change having been filed with the County Highway Committee, and with the County Clerk of said County, by the State Highway Commission, as required by Section 83.08; and the said County Highway Committee having dealt by contract with the owner of said lands.

That the said owner for a valuable consideration, to-wit: the sum of \$200. do hereby grant and convey to La Crosse County, Wisconsin for highway purposes as long as so used, the lands of said owners necessary for said relocation, shown on the said plat and described as follows, to-wit: A parcel of land 4 rods wide in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19 in Township 16 North of Range 6 West, La Crosse County, Wisconsin, the center line of which is described as follows:

~~Commencing at the junction of Malters Road and County Trunk "O"~~
at a point 123 feet East of, and 702 feet North of the center $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 19 in Township 16 North of Range 6 West, thence Southeasterly 2801 feet to a point on the East line of Section 19; thence 490 feet South of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner on said line, and crossing said line at an angle of 40 degrees 15 minutes.

All of the above described land to be new right of way, except that portion contained in the present highway, and to contain approximately 1.0 acre.

The consideration mentioned herein includes all right of way taken and for damages occasioned due to the necessity of moving fence.
