





I projected the occupied South line of the SE-NW-32-15-5 West and intersected it with an old line fence to the South of the East 1/4 of Section 31. I found that this occupied corner best fits the field evidence found in Sections 31 and 32. It also fits very well S. Middlebrook's section surveys done in 1876. Also, I found a piece of steel farm disk at this location. I monumented the corner with

a Lunde marker.


