

I found a point where the fence has two posts and ties wire going North and South. Mr. Stakston, a longtime resident, testified that this location has always been the accepted section corner on the county line. My measurements show this point fits the overall section data very well. I accepted this location as the best available evidence of the original government corner position and monumented it with an iron pipe.

Describe or show any material discrepancy between the location of the restored corner and that of the corner previously restored or reestablished.


