

- I found the 1" iron pipe set by Jung at the location computed from his tie sheet.
- I noticed that the occupation used by Jung must have been based on the survey by Knower.
- I accepted the 1" iron pipe as the best available evidence of the original government corner and replaced it with a Vernon County Lunde Monument.
- I found old rotten wood in the bog when digging for the new monument. It is unclear if it is the remnants of the fence post that Jung mentions on his tie sheet, there is no post located at the site now.

Describe or show any material discrepancy between the location of the restored corner and that of the corner previously restored or re-established.


Uriah Biggs established this corner in October 1845.

Wm Knower was at this corner, in November 1889, during a survey in Section 3. He shows that he found the government corner.

William Jung was at this corner, in February 1988. He re—established this corner based on occupation and set a 1" iron pipe.




PLAN VIEW DRAWING OF REFERENCE TIES




I accepted the old occupied 3-way fence corner as the best available evidence of the original government corner position and monumented it with an iron pipe.
